

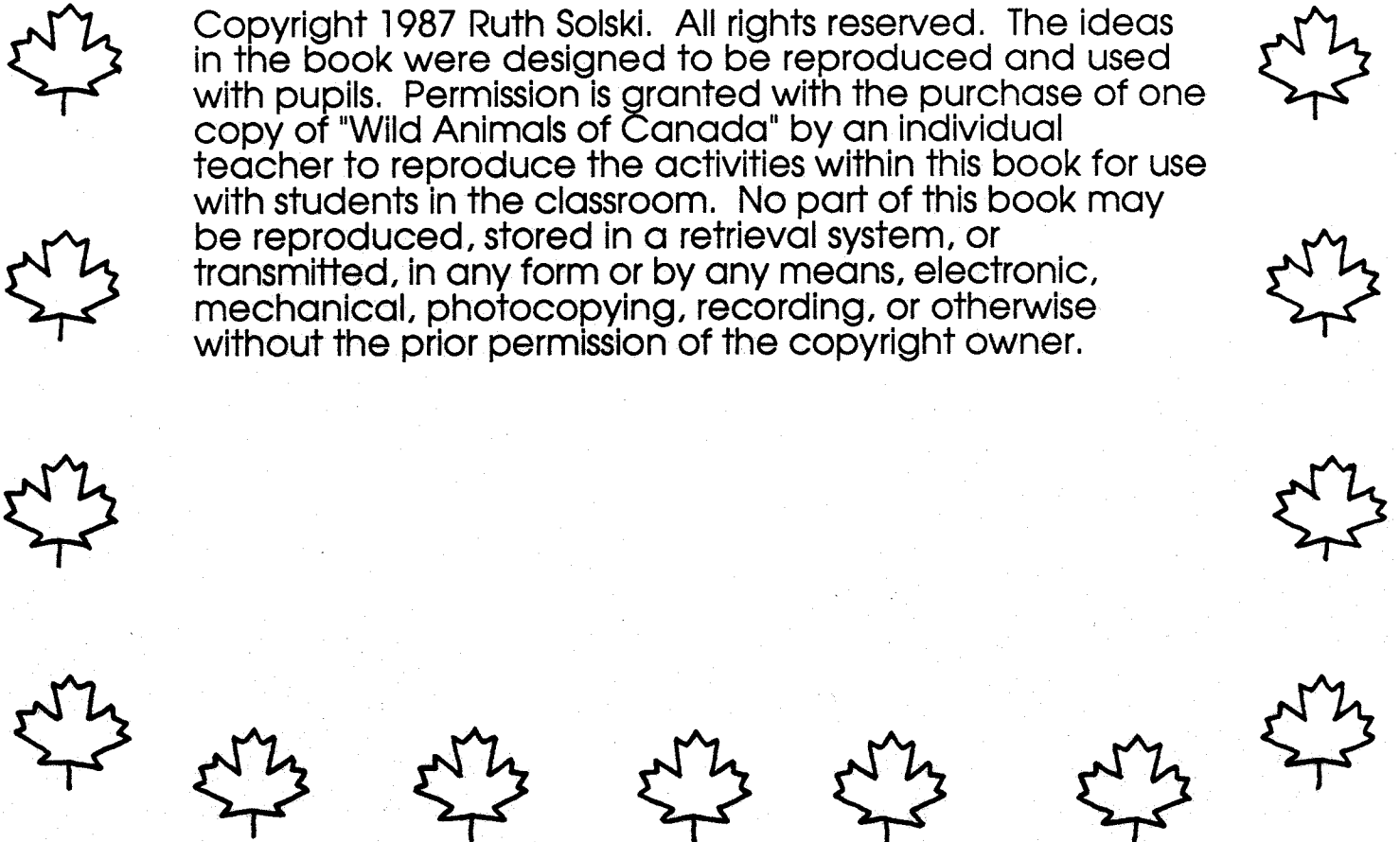

ANIMAL COVERINGS

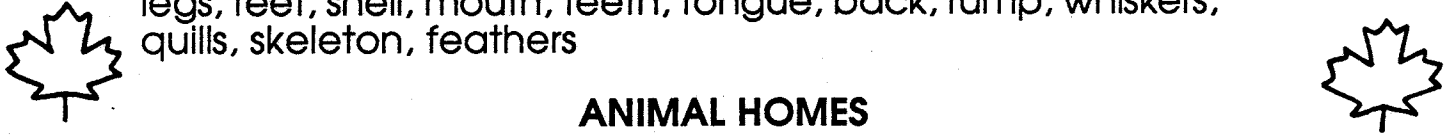
hair, fur, wool, skin, feathers, hide, quills, stripes, spotted, hairy, velvety, smooth, shaggy, scales





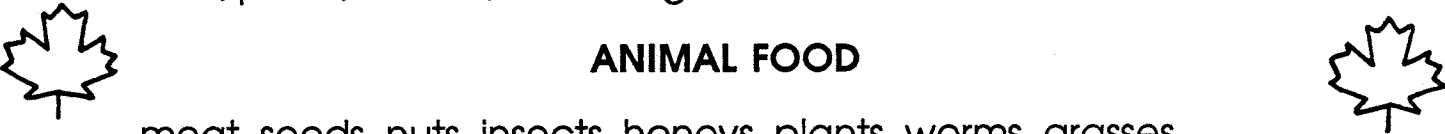
ANIMAL BODY PARTS

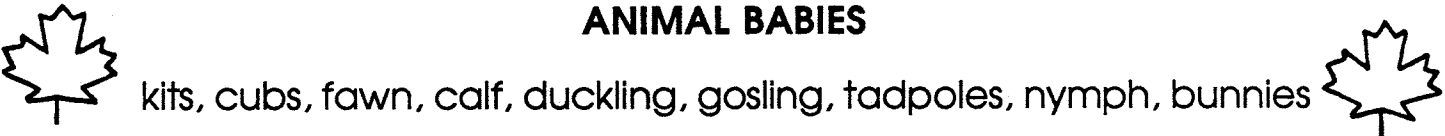
ANIMAL HOMES

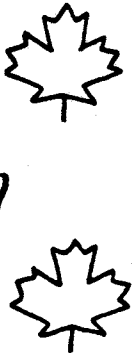
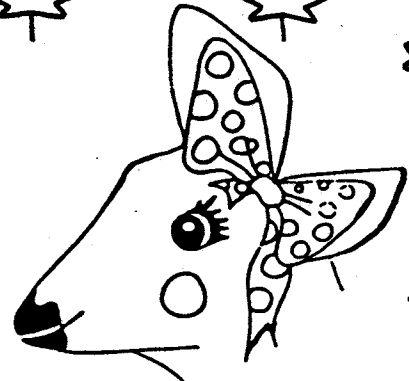
