### Getting To Know Me

### Introduction to Activities

Begin with oral activities. Choose a small number of pictures from the Visual Aids cards (pages 59-61) and name them, having the student repeat after you. Give him/her duplicate cards to match to the original set. Play a matching game with the pairs of cards, turning them over for a greater challenge. Add to the number of cards you use each day until the student has mastered all of the vocabulary.

Teach songs, chants or fingerplays related to the key vocabulary, such as "Head and Shoulders, Knees and Toes" to provide additional oral practice for the student.

Play "Tic Tac Toe" or "Body Bingo" for a few minutes each day to provide repetition of the key vocabulary. (Provided on pages 9-13) You may wish to use a peer buddy to do this with the ESL student.

Use page 14 to reinforce word recognition describing the head and face.

Use page 15 to reinforce word recognition describing the body. The student should draw the face and hair.


Page 16, "Where do I belong?" should be done together with the student. Note whether or not he/she is able to read each word independently. If not, read it aloud and assist the student with placing the word in the correct column.

Make sufficient copies of page 17, "Family Picture Cards" for the student to color, cut out
and glue onto construction paper squares, for greater durability. Use them for oral
practice first; i.e. "This is my father. His name is" Make a set of the word
cards provided on page 18 to use for a matching game.

The final activity in this secton, found on pages 19 and 20 is a booklet for the student to list and illustrate his or her personal information.
