Bunnacula by Deborah and James Howe

 Complete 3 activities in a row (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal.) If you choose to complete the center box FIRST, then you may select **any** other 2 activities to complete. Check them as you complete each one.

<p>Chester uncovers some clues that lead him to believe that Bunnacula is a vampire. List all the clues in order as they appear in the story. Look at each clue carefully and write your opinion as to whether Chester <u>interpreted</u> these clues correctly or not.</p> <p>VL</p>	<p>Chester <u>exhibited</u> some unusual behavior for a cat. Imagine that the Monroes bring Chester to you, Dr. Kit E. Katz, a famous cat <u>psychiatrist</u>, for help. Make a medical record for Chester in which you list his behavior, your <u>diagnosis</u> and <u>prognosis</u> and how you plan to <u>counsel</u> Chester.</p> <p>VL</p>	<p>Create a "Hare Hop" dance or game. Write directions and teach others. If you created a dance, research to find out about the "Bunny Hop" dance that was popular in days gone by. Compare the two dances. If you created a game, compare it with an old favorite "Hopscotch."</p> <p>MR</p>

First give author information, then list and describe characters. Summarize the story and write recommendations, <u>substantiated</u> with <u>excerpts</u> from the story.</p> <p>Inter</p>	<p>Imagine a <u>scenario</u> in which Chester and Bunnacula are left on your doorstep with a note asking you to take good care of them. Write a short story telling how you feel about and <u>interact</u> with your new pets.</p> <p>Intra</p>
<p>Make a story <u>mobile</u>. Include the title and author as well as the main characters.</p> <p>VS</p>	<p>Create a "Bunnacula" board game, write instructions and share with others.</p> <p>BK</p>	<p>What Chester, Harold and Bunnacula ate played an important part in the story and was not always what is recommended for animals.
